### DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Coming from all directions, you will arrive on the RING of Brussels.

From Antwerp [E19]: Follow signs NAMUR/BRUSSELS (E40)

From Liège [Luik]/Leuven[Louvain] [E40]: Follow BRUSSELS

From Namur/Luxembourg [E411]: Follow LIEGE/LEUVEN, then follow direction BRUSSELS (E40)

Then follow BRUSSELS CENTRE/EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (tunnel REYERS). Coming out of the tunnel you are now on AVENUE DE CORTENBERGH and we are on your right hand side – see [AREA MAP](#)

Please note: As parking spaces for visitors are limited, they are only granted on request. They will be allocated on a first-come first-serve basis. To make a reservation, please make a request in advance of the event or meeting to the contact person mentioned in the invitation.

### FROM AND TO THE AIRPORT

**By Taxi:** Transportation takes approximately 20-40 minutes to the FTA/BSCI office depending on traffic.

**By Airport Express Bus (4€):** Bus 12 is a shuttle bus between the city centre and the airport. It stops at Rond Point Schuman, which is a 5 min. walk from the office (see [AREA MAP](#)), departing every 20 min in both directions. Journey time is approx. 30 min.

### TRAIN

Arriving at BRUSSELS MIDI (BRUSSELS SOUTH) with Thalys, TGV or Eurostar, the following connections are available:

- Trains depart frequently from Brussels Midi to Brussels Schuman station - click on [SNCB](#) for departure times
- Taxi transfers take approx. 10-15 minutes
- Metro transportation takes approx. 10-15 min - take metro line 2 direction SIMONIS; change at ARTS/LOI to line 1a direction Hermann-Debroux or 1b direction Stockel, step off at SCHUMAN; walk up avenue de Cortenberg (5 min.) – see [AREA MAP](#)
